

9 Tips to Protect Your Home and Family from Pests

Your home is your refuge against inclement weather. It gives you and your family shelter, warmth, and comfort.

These same qualities attract pests — like rodents, spiders, and cockroaches — to invite themselves in and make themselves at home. And that's why these pests are always more of a threat during the cooler months of the year.

To help you keep your home and family safe from pests this fall, check out these tips from the National Pest Management Association:

- 1. Install door sweeps on exterior doors, and repair damaged screens.
- 2. Screen vents and openings to chimneys.
- 3. Seal cracks and crevices on the outside of the home, including areas where

Grab-N-Go (Gluten-Free) Pancake Muffins

Recipe from The Kitchenthusiast™ — a KitchenAid® blog

INGREDIENTS:

¼ c. plain yogurt

2 T. unsalted butter, melted

2 T. pure maple syrup

½ t. pure vanilla extract

1½ c. blanched almond flour

½ t. baking soda

¼ t. sea salt

2 eggs

1 egg white

c. diced fresh berries

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 350. Grease a 6-cavity muffin pan with butter. Set aside.

Place all liquid ingredients into a blender or food processor, except for the eggs. Then place all dry ingredients on top. Cover and blend on low 10-15 seconds, just long enough to combine the ingredients (the batter will be thick). Add the eggs and egg white; blend on low 20-30 seconds, just until the eggs are well incorporated into the batter (do not overmix or the muffins will not be tender).

Fill each cavity of the prepared pan full. Add a few berries to each cup. Then divide the remaining batter evenly among the muffin cups, and top with additional berries.

Bake for 18-20 minutes, until slightly golden brown on top and a toothpick inserted in the middle comes out clean.

utilities and pipes enter.

- 4. Store food in airtight containers.
- **5. Dispose of garbage regularly** in sealed receptacles.
- **6. Replace loose mortar and weather stripping** around the foundation and windows.
- **7. Eliminate all moisture sites,** including leaking pipes and clogged drains.
- 8. Store firewood at least 20 feet away from the home.
- 9. Keep shrubbery well-trimmed.

Of course, if you suspect a pest infestation problem in your home, you should consult with a licensed pest professional to inspect, identify and treat the problem. We suggest locally owned and operated CSI Exterminators (www.csi-ext.com • 559-294-1779).

BONUS TIP: Peppermint essential oil is a natural repellent of both mice and spiders (and ants, too). Soak a cotton ball or cotton pad with the oil and place in areas where you see evidence of the pests. You also can mix 4-5 drops of the oil in a spray bottle of water for a spray-on treatment.
