

Protect Your Home, Keep Your Family Safe From Fire!

Fire kills 4,000 and injures 20,000 Americans each year, and U.S. fire departments respond to 1.5 million home fires each year ... according to the U.S. Fire Administration.

We don't want you to be one of these statistics!

You should have working smoke alarms in each bedroom and on each floor of your home to alert your family if a fire should occur. But here are some steps you can take to protect your home and prevent a fire from starting in the first place ...

Home Fire Safety Checklist:

$\hfill\Box$ Check electrical appliances for loose or frayed cords. Do not place wires under rugs.
$\hfill\Box$ Check for outlets overloaded with plugs; including TVs, game consoles, computers, and printers.
☐ Install GFCI (ground fault circuit interrupter) outlets in your home; especially near water in your bathroom, kitchen and laundry room.

Candy Corn Marshmallow Pops

Recipe from Better Homes & Gardens (bhg.com)

INGREDIENTS:

Large marshmallows

Candy coating discs -1 package each orange and yellow (such as Candy Melts[®] by Wilton)

Straws

Orange and black nonpareils (optional)

DIRECTIONS:

Place orange and yellow candy coating discs in separate microwave-safe bowls. Microwave separately on high until melted and smooth, stopping to stir every 30 seconds.

Insert straws into bases of large marshmallows.

Dip part or all of each marshmallow in candy coating, spooning it over if necessary and letting excess drip off into bowl.

If desired, sprinkle with orange and black nonpareils.

Lay marshmallows on waxed paper (or insert straws into florist's foam to avoid a flat side) to let harden.

For two-layer candy corn marshmallows, omit the nonpareils. After the first coating layer has firmed up, dip the marshmallow in a second color of candy coating, keeping the first layer of coating visible. Let stand on waxed paper or in florist's foam until coating is firm.

 \square If any appliances spark, smell unusual, or overheat, replace them or get them repaired by a professional.

☐ Check that lamps and nightlights are not touching any fabrics (bedspreads, drapes).

☐ Be sure that electrical blankets are unplugged when not in use. Check for frayed or loose cords and any odd smell. If you detect a problem, replace the blanket immediately.

 $\hfill\square$ Supervise children around the stove and microwave.

☐ Candles should be out of reach of children and pets, and away from curtains and furniture. Never leave candles unattended.

 $\hfill\square$ Get an annual inspection of your furnace or heating system.
