INGREDIENTS:

- ¹/₂ c. butter 1 package (12 oz.) semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 2 eqqs
- 1 box (16 oz.) powdered sugar
- 1 t. vanilla
- 1 c. chopped nuts (optional)

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Melt butter and chocolate chips together over low heat, then set aside.
- 2. In a large bowl, beat the eggs until light. Add the powdered sugar, and beat until smooth. Mix in the vanilla.
- 3. Add the melted chocolate mixture and chopped nuts. Mix well.
- 4. Pour into a buttered 8 x 8 pan, and chill until set. Cut into squares and enjoy with family and friends!
